



Qualification for Nursery and Early Years Teachers

Diploma in Children's Services (Early Childhood Education and Care) - CHC50908

This is a management diploma adapted to the specific needs of the childcare sector. The Diploma is designed for those with several years experience of working in the childcare industry who have (or aspire to have) responsibility for supervision of other staff and/or volunteers.

Content
